

Lead line Walk-Trot Test B

REQUIREMENTS: Walk-Trot on lead line or off. Walking off lead, rider will receive **2** additional points added to their total score. Trot may be done rising or sitting. Rider must be under the age of 12. Assistant must wear protective footwear.

PURPOSE: This is an introduction to dressage for the beginner child rider. Have fun!!!!

1	A Enter in Walk, G Halt and Salute, Proceed in Walk towards C	Rider's position; straightness on center line; clarity and accuracy of salute.	10	
2	C Track right, Between M and R Develop trot. R Circle right 20 meters in trot.	Rider's position; development of trot; accuracy of circle and consistency of trot.	10	
3	Between R and B Develop walk P Turn right L Turn right	Rider's position; transition to walk; consistency of walk; straightness on centerline; accuracy of turns at P and L.	10	
4	C Track left, Between H and S Develop trot. S Circle right 20 meters in trot.	Rider's position; development of trot; accuracy of circle and consistency of trot.	10	
5	Between S and E Develop walk V Turn left L Turn left G Halt and Salute	Rider's position; transition to walk; accuracy of turns at V and L; straightness on center line; clarity and accuracy of salute.	10	
6	Rider answer a judge question:	Rider could be asked the color of the mount or to touch the withers, mane, or neck	10
