

## Lead line Walk-Trot Test A

**REQUIREMENTS:** Walk-Trot on lead line or off. Walking off lead, rider will receive **2** additional points added to their total score. Trot may be done rising or sitting. Rider must be under the age of 12. Assistant must wear protective footwear.

**PURPOSE:** This is an introduction to dressage for the beginner child rider. Have fun!!!!

1	<b>A</b> Enter in Walk, <b>G</b> Halt and Salute,  Proceed in Walk towards C	Rider's position; straightness on center line; clarity and accuracy of salute.	10	
2	<b>C</b> Track right,  <b>C</b> Circle right 20 meters.  Anywhere on circle, develop 10 to 20 steps of trot. Before C, return to walk.	Rider's position; development of trot; accuracy of circle and transition to walk.	10	
3	<b>C</b> Straight ahead,  <b>MXK</b> Change rein in walk	Rider's position; straightness across the diagonal.	10	
4	<b>A</b> Circle left 20 meters.  Anywhere on circle, develop 10 to 20 steps of trot. Before A, return to walk.	Rider's position; development of trot; accuracy of circle and transition to walk.	10	
5	<b>A</b> Turn down center line,  <b>G</b> Halt and Salute	Rider's position; accuracy of turn at A; straightness on center line; clarity and accuracy of salute.	10	
6	Rider answer a judge question:	Rider could be asked the color of the mount or to touch the withers, mane, or neck	10
